## **General**

Locker padlock (maximum 4mm diameter shackle) – key or combination

## **All year wear:**

Navy blazer with school crest on pocket

Navy v-neck pullover

Navy sleeveless slipover - optional

Regulation skirt

Regulation blouse

Shower-proof fleece with school crest

Plain navy or black flat shoes, heels no more than one inch at lowest point – **no narrow heels, open-toes or sandals**

## **Uniform Rules:**

No bracelet, ring or necklace may be worn.

A cross and chain/Star of David may be permitted on receipt of a written request.

One pair of small plain ear studs/sleeper rings are acceptable.

**Tongue, eyebrow and nose piercings are not acceptable.**

Long hair, or hair that falls over the face, must be tied back with suitable blue fastenings.  
Hair must be of one natural colour.  
Nail varnish and make up are not allowed.
