Uniform rules

Jewellery: No bracelets, rings or necklaces may be worn. A cross or Star of David may be permitted on receipt of a written request. One pair of small plain ear studs or sleeper rings is acceptable. Earrings must be removed for PE and Games. Tongue, eyebrow and nose piercings are not acceptable.

Hair: Long hair must be worn tied back with blue or black hair ties. Hair must be of natural colour.

Nail varnish and make-up are not allowed.

Naming: All items should be clearly marked with your daughter's name.

For religious reasons, any student may wear plain black or navy blue leggings underneath the school kilt. If parents wish their daughter to cover her head, this should be with a plain yellow headscarf, which can be supplied by the school, firmly tied at the back of the neck and tucked into the blouse collar. For safety reasons, loose veils may not be worn.
